EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

- Mono hazard and season focussed
- Tactical driven rather than strategically directed
- Event centred rather than programmatic
- Agency coopted as opposed to agency commitment

CHANGING LANDSCAPE

- Frequent catastrophic events
- Diversity in nature of hazard impacts
- Multi-hazard and integrated approaches
- ICT Acceleration
- Emergence of trans-boundary threats
